

February meeting minutes (continued)

CURTIS - SEED STARTING - FROM CROSS POLLINATING FLOWERS. PLANT YOUR GARDEN BASED ON WHAT YOU ARE LOOKING TO TRY FOR.

GERMINATING YOUR SEEDS - PUTTING YOUR SEED BTWN LAYERS OF WET PAPERTOWELS - SLIT SIDES OF A ZIP LOCK BAG FOR EASY ACCESS - PUT IN A WARM LOCATION. YOU CAN STACK MULTIPLE BAGS. AFTER 3-4 DAYS CHECK, THEN CHECK DAILY LOOKING FOR ROOTS. AFTER ROUGHLY A WEEK WHATEVER IS GOING TO GERMINATE WILL. TRANSPLANT TO SOIL. BOTTOM WATER ONLY TO AVOID DAMP OFF. AGAIN KEEP IN WARM PLACE IF NOT ABLE TO THEN USE A HEATING PAD BUT BE CAREFUL TO NOT COOK THEM. ALSO KEEP IN LIT AREA OTHERWISE USE A SHOPLIGHT. OKAY TO USE SEED STARTER OR POTTING SOIL/PEAT MOSS IN 50/50 MIX. MAYBE USE A DILUTED MIRACLE GROW ONCE WHEN ITS IN A PEET POT.

CHRIS DIX -. HE GAVE A DEMO ON CUTTINGS FROM POT ROOTS. CUT 1\8 OF AN INCH BELOW LEAF NODE. WHEN PUTTING IT IN THE OASIS, PUT HALF WAY DOWN AND MAKE SURE THE NODE HAS GOOD CONTACT AND IS BELOW THE SURFACE OF THE OASIS. THE LARGER (OLDER) THE CUTTING THE LESS LIKELY IT IS TO TAKE. IN 10 DAYS YOU SHOULD BE ABLE TO GET MORE CUTTINGS FROM THE SAME PLANT. IN APPROX. 18 DAYS YOU CAN TRANSFER THE CUTTINGS IN THE OASIS CUBES TO SOIL. PULL THE CUBES AND CHECK FOR ROOTS - NO ROOTS WAIT. ROOTS TRANSFER TO 4 INCH POTS. NEED LIGHT. ONCE A WEEK, LIGHTLY FERTILIZE. KEEP MOIST BUT NOT WET. CUTTING CAN BE PLANTED OUTSIDE IN MID MAY.

- ** Opportunity to participate in the annual dahlia show.




